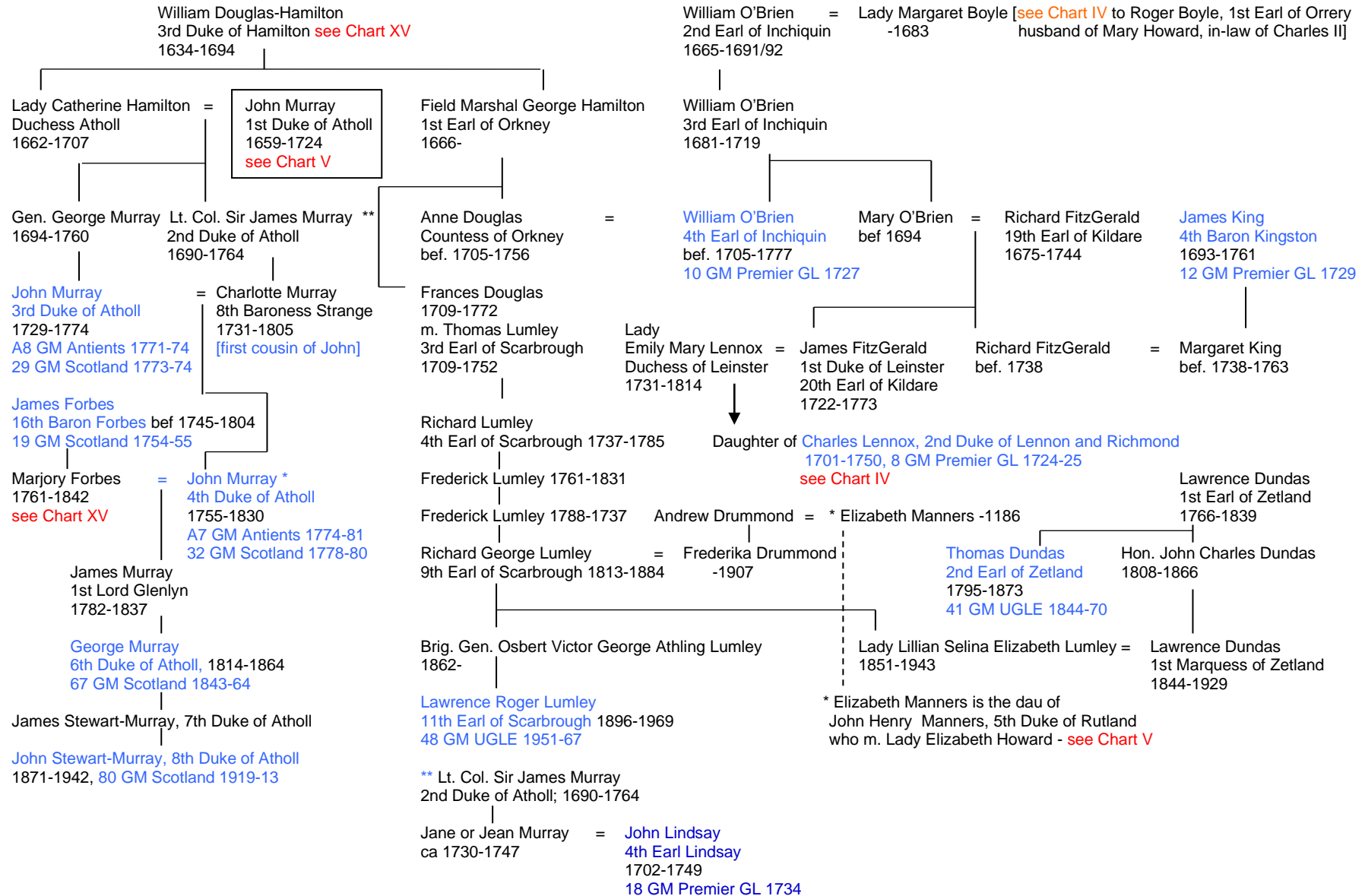

Murray, O'Brien, King, Lumley, Dundas

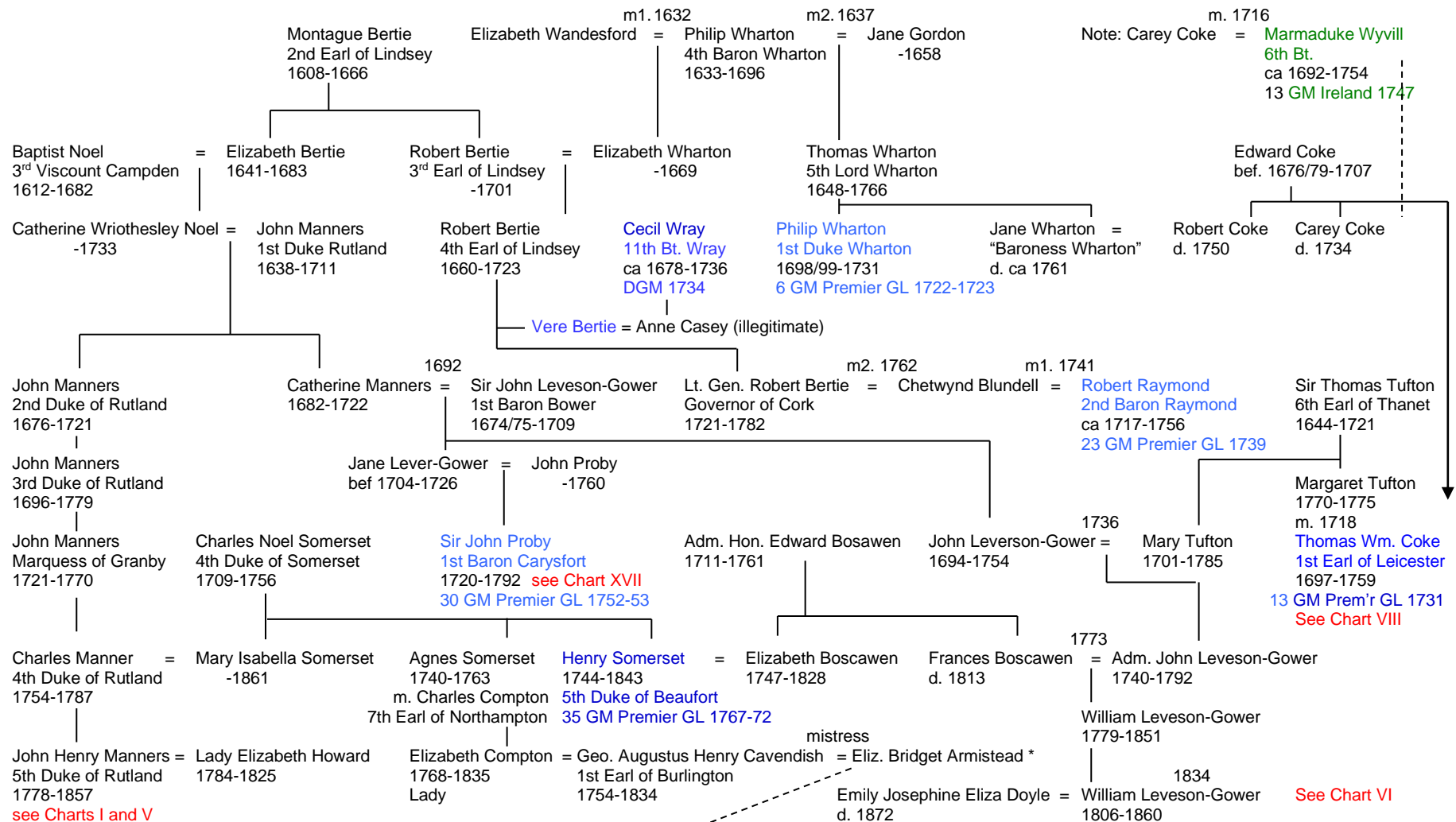

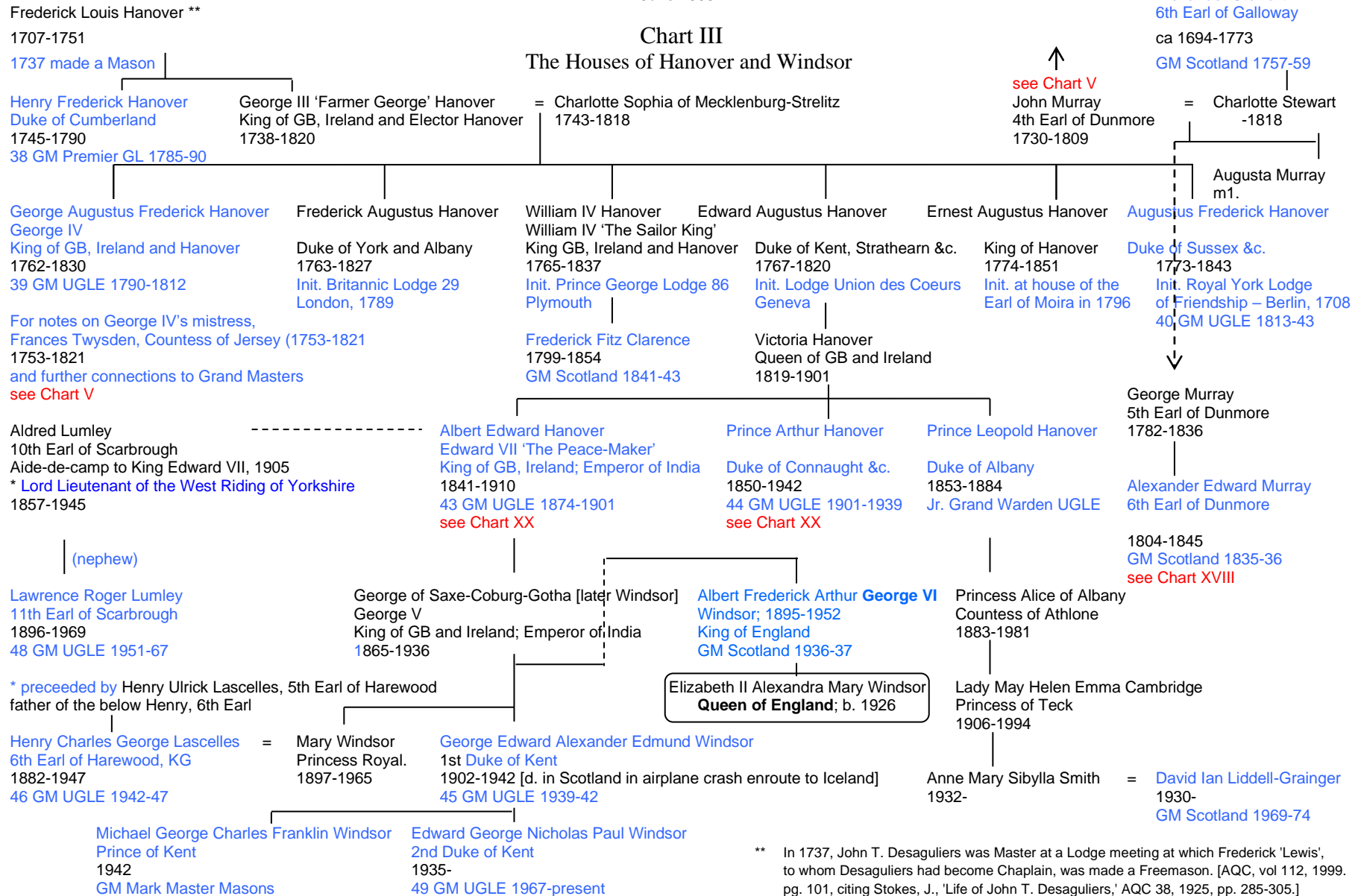

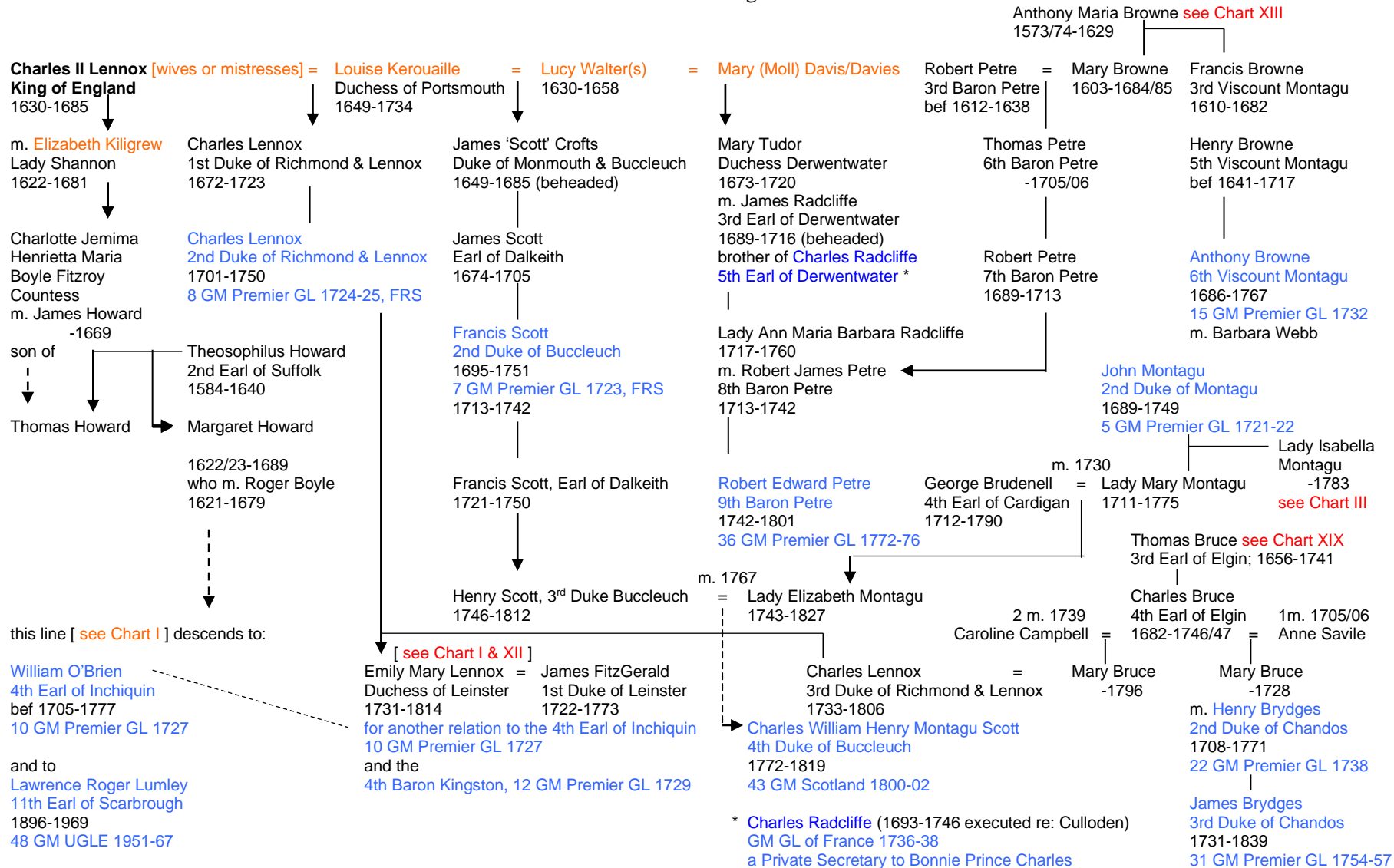
The Houses of Hanover and Windsor

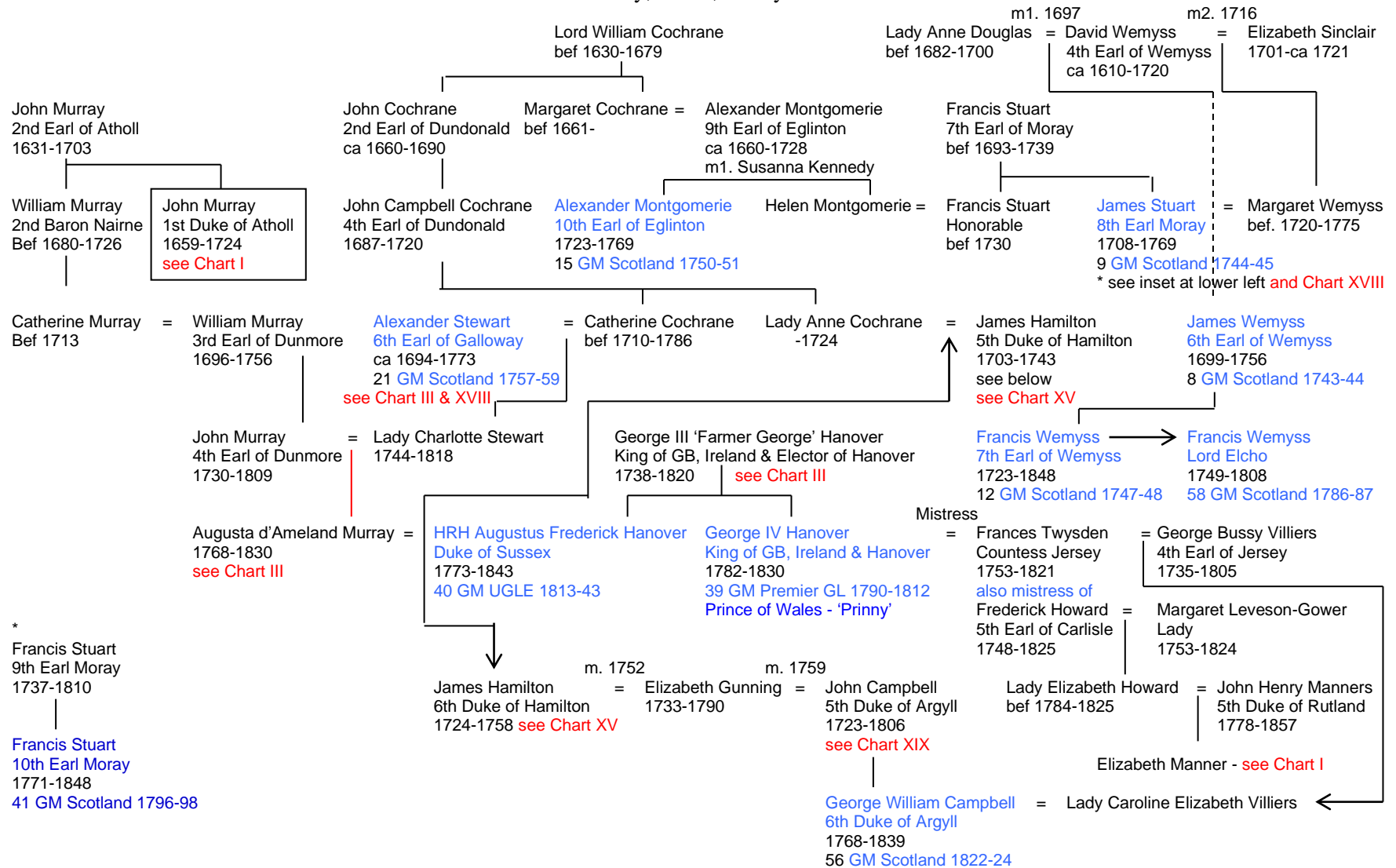
Chart IV

Chart V Murray, Stuart, Wemyss

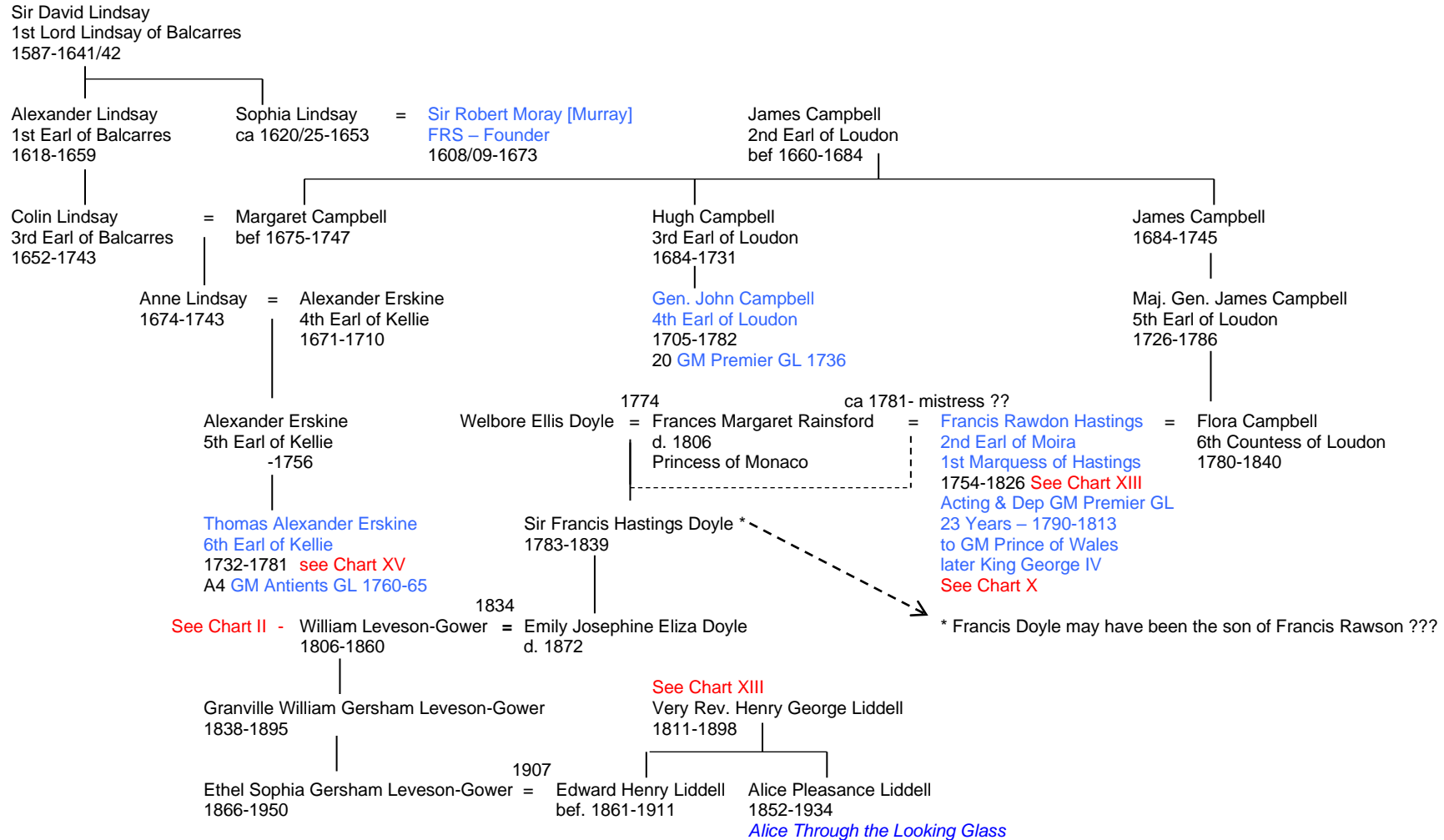

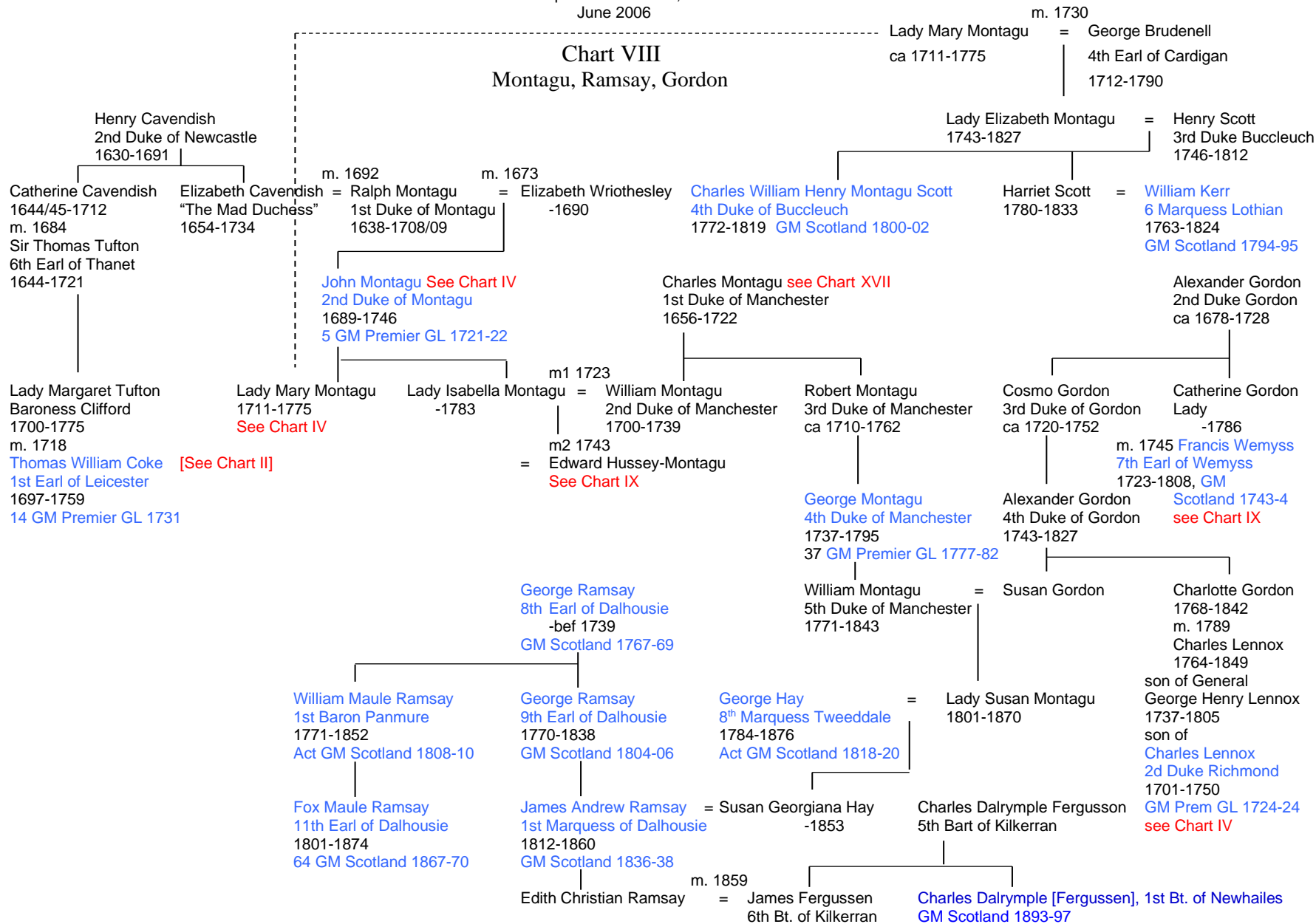

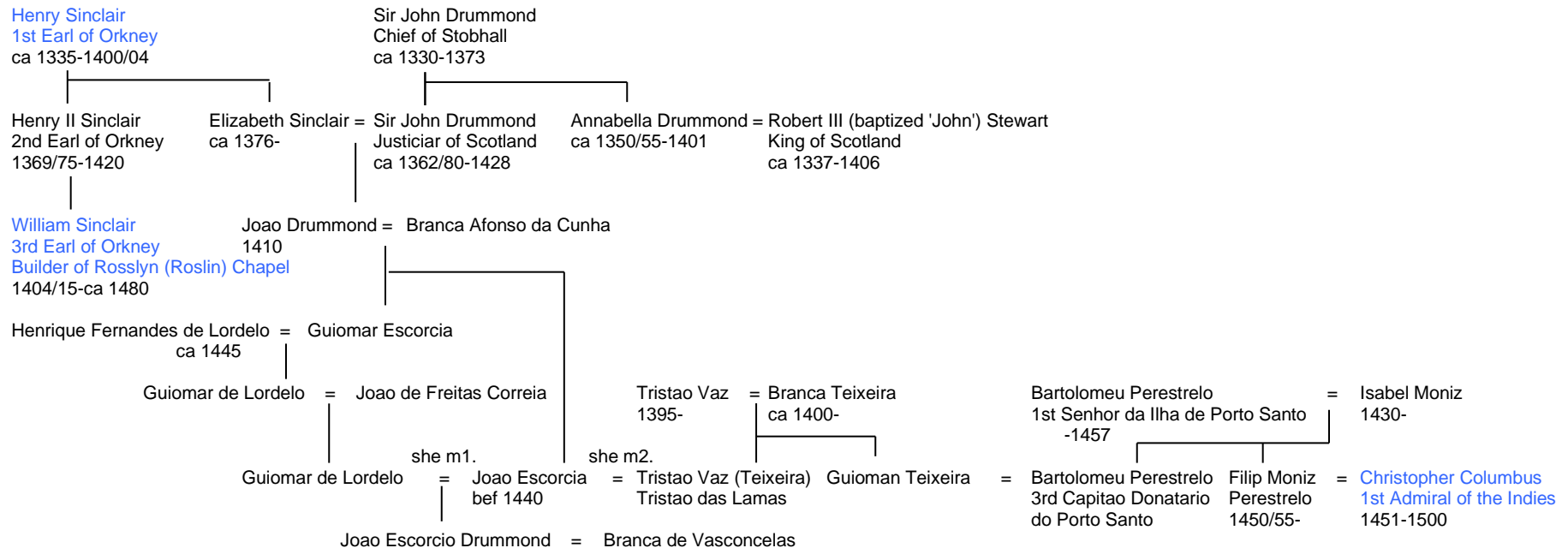
Chart X Wesley, Hamilton, MacDonnell, Kerr

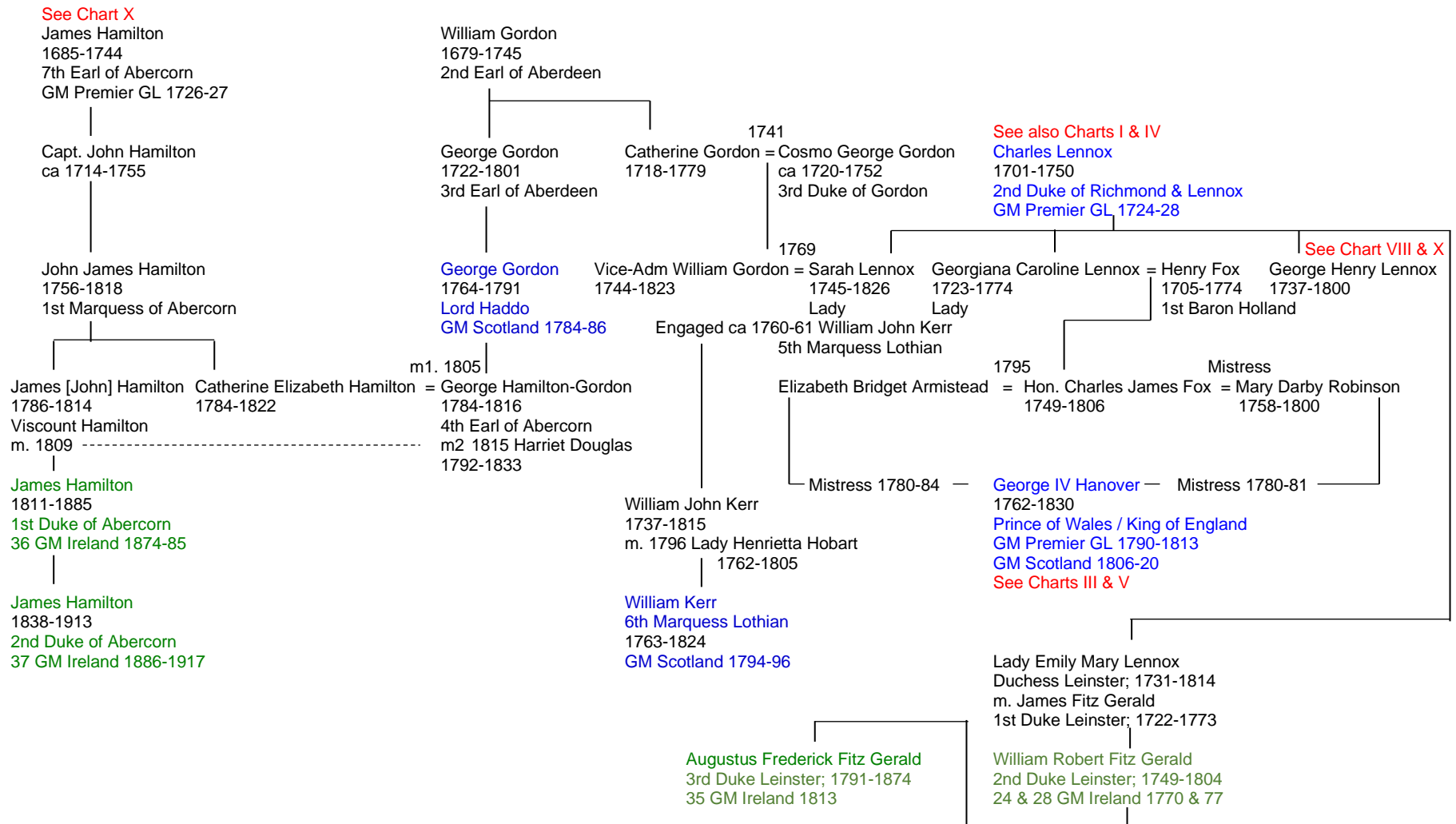

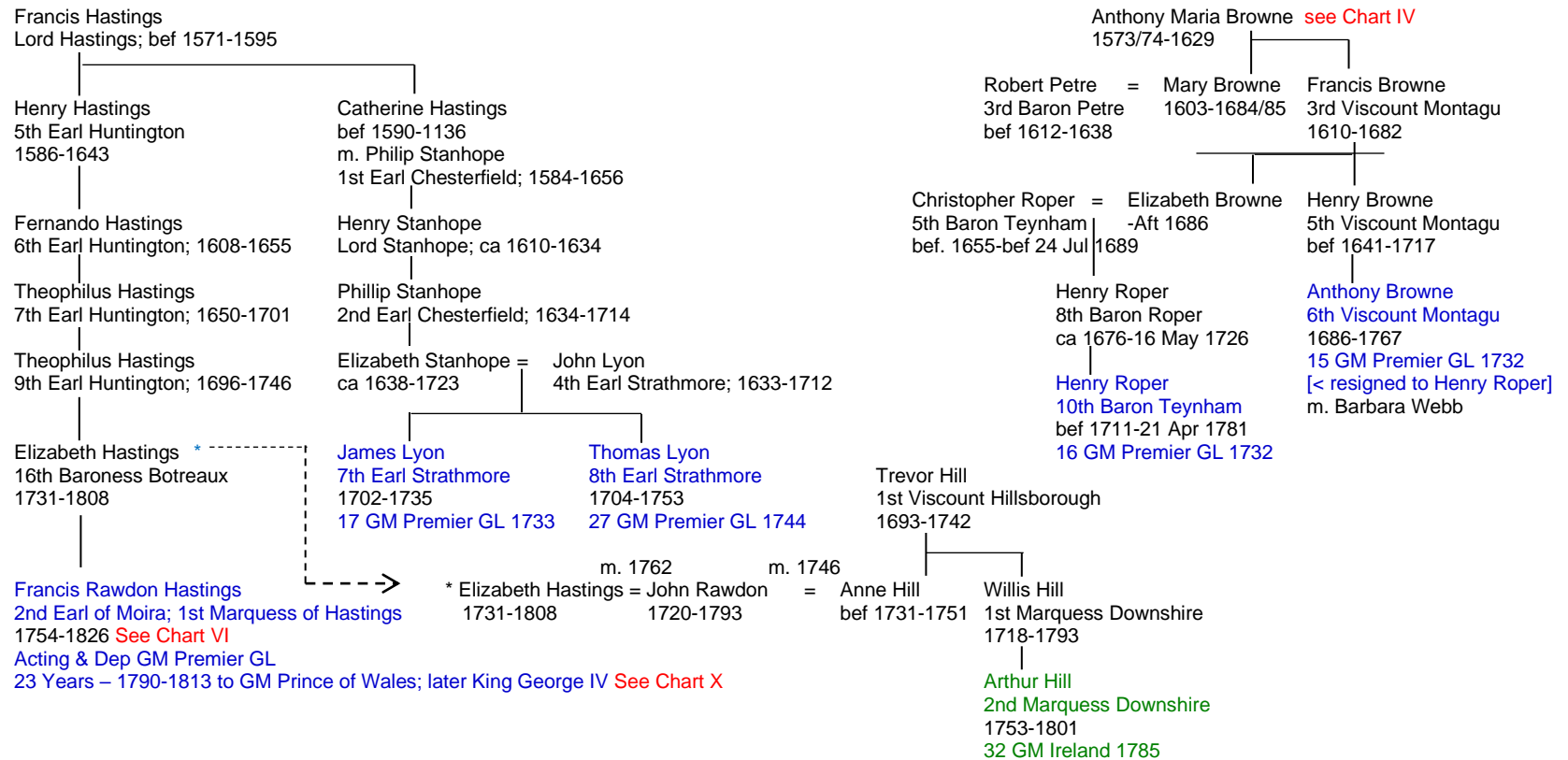

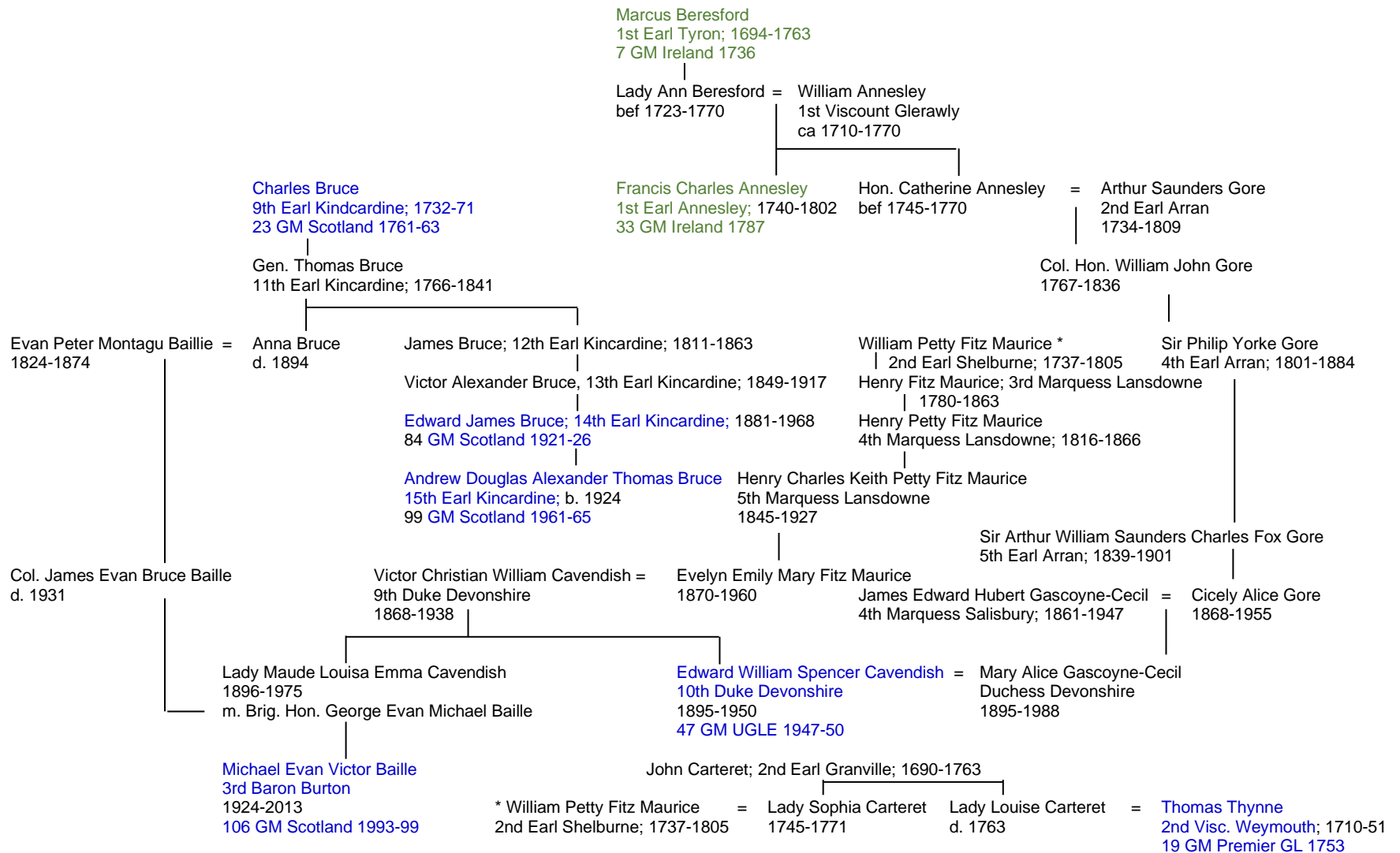

His brother Archibald (b. 22 Apr 1736; d.8 May 1797) became 7th [Earl of Kellie](#), but he died unmarried with no heir.
The title went to the 7th Earl's third cousin once removed, Charles Erskine, 8th Earl Kellie, whose father, also named Charles Erskine (1730-1790), was 6th Baronet of Cambo (one of the [Erskine Baronets](#)) and the son of David Erskine, Lyon-Clerk who died 7 Oct 1769.

Another of David's sons, was [Thomas Erskine, 9th Earl of Kellie](#).

When the 9th Earl died in 1828, his brother, Methven Erskine became 10th Earl Kellie.

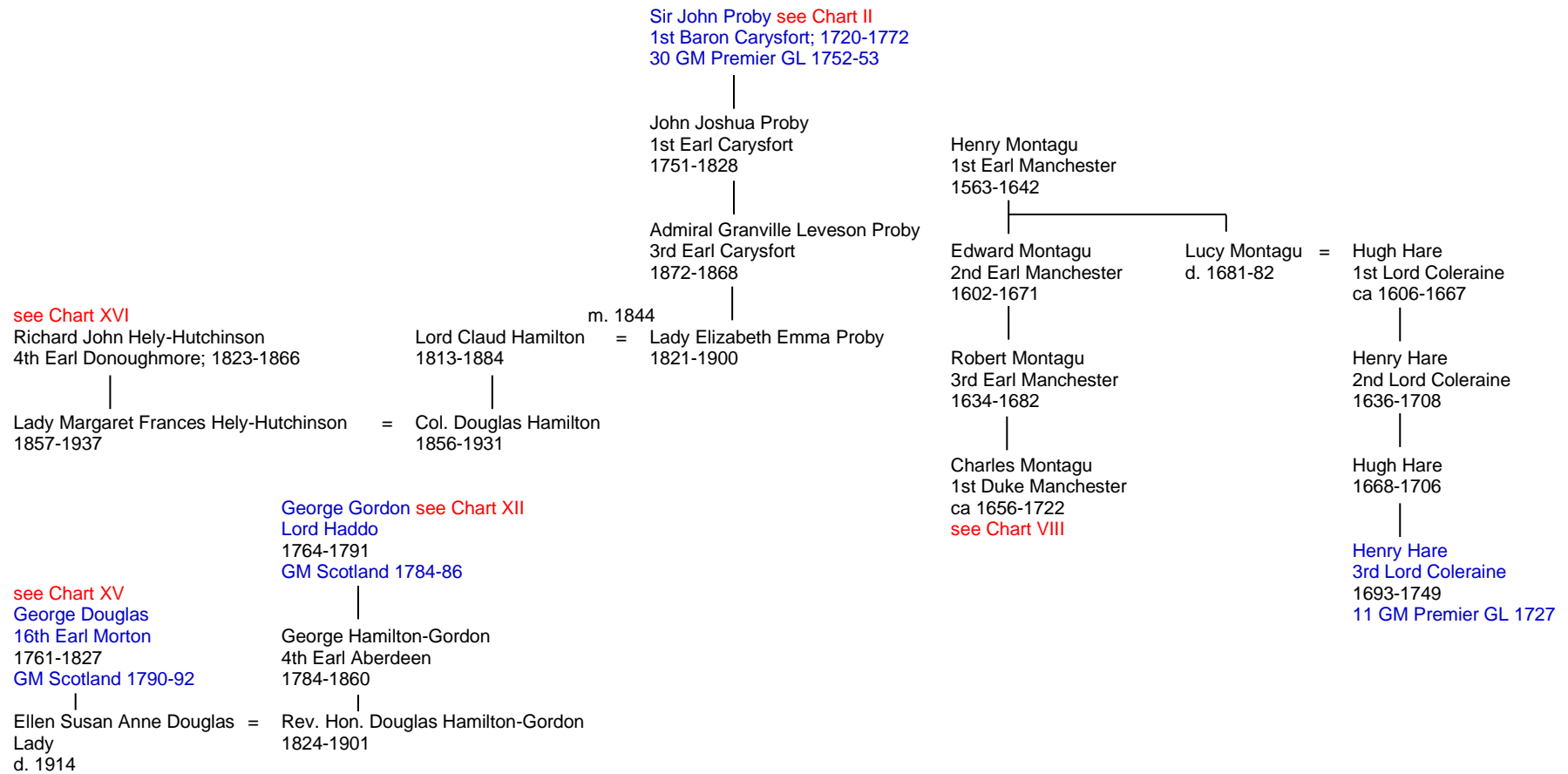

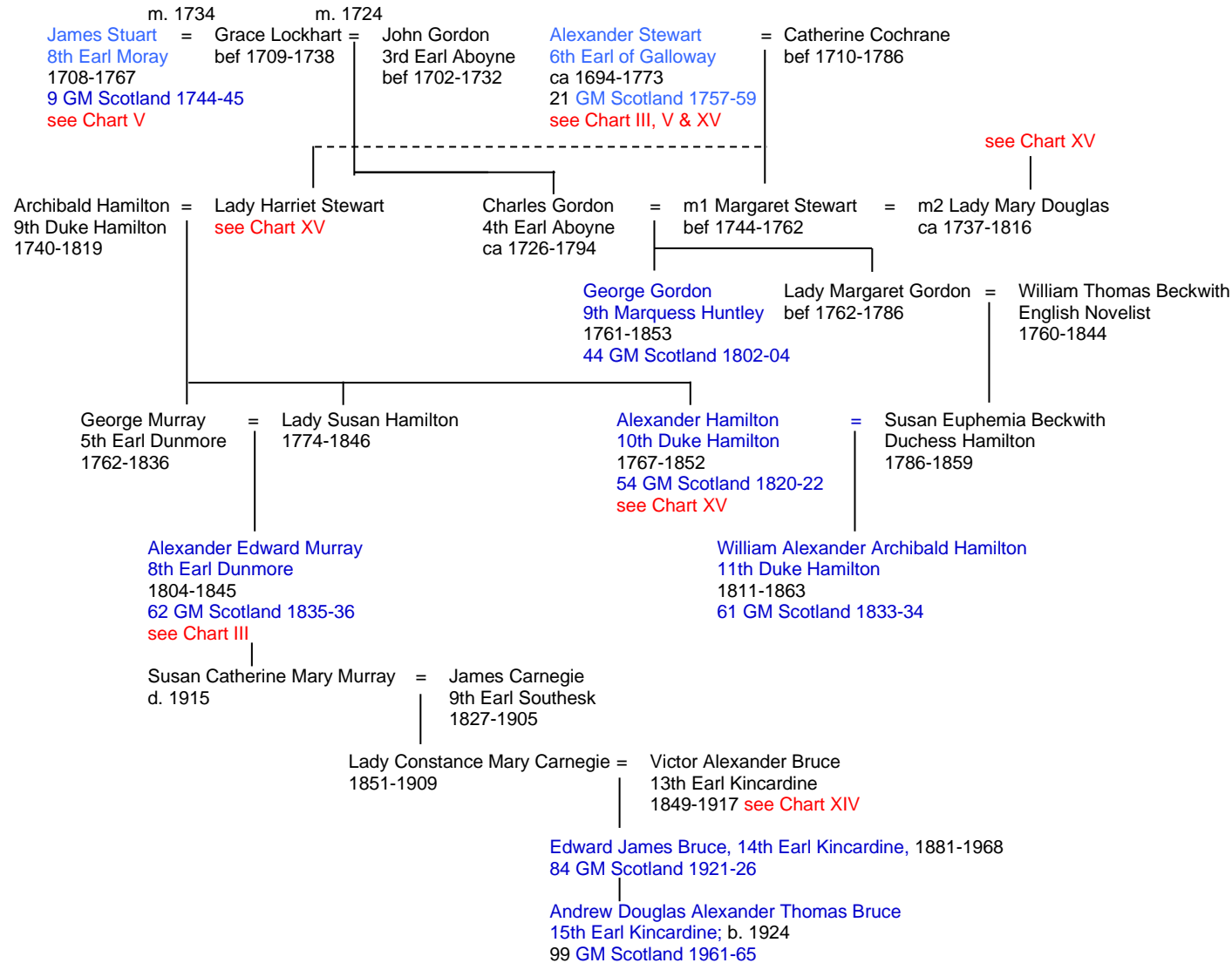

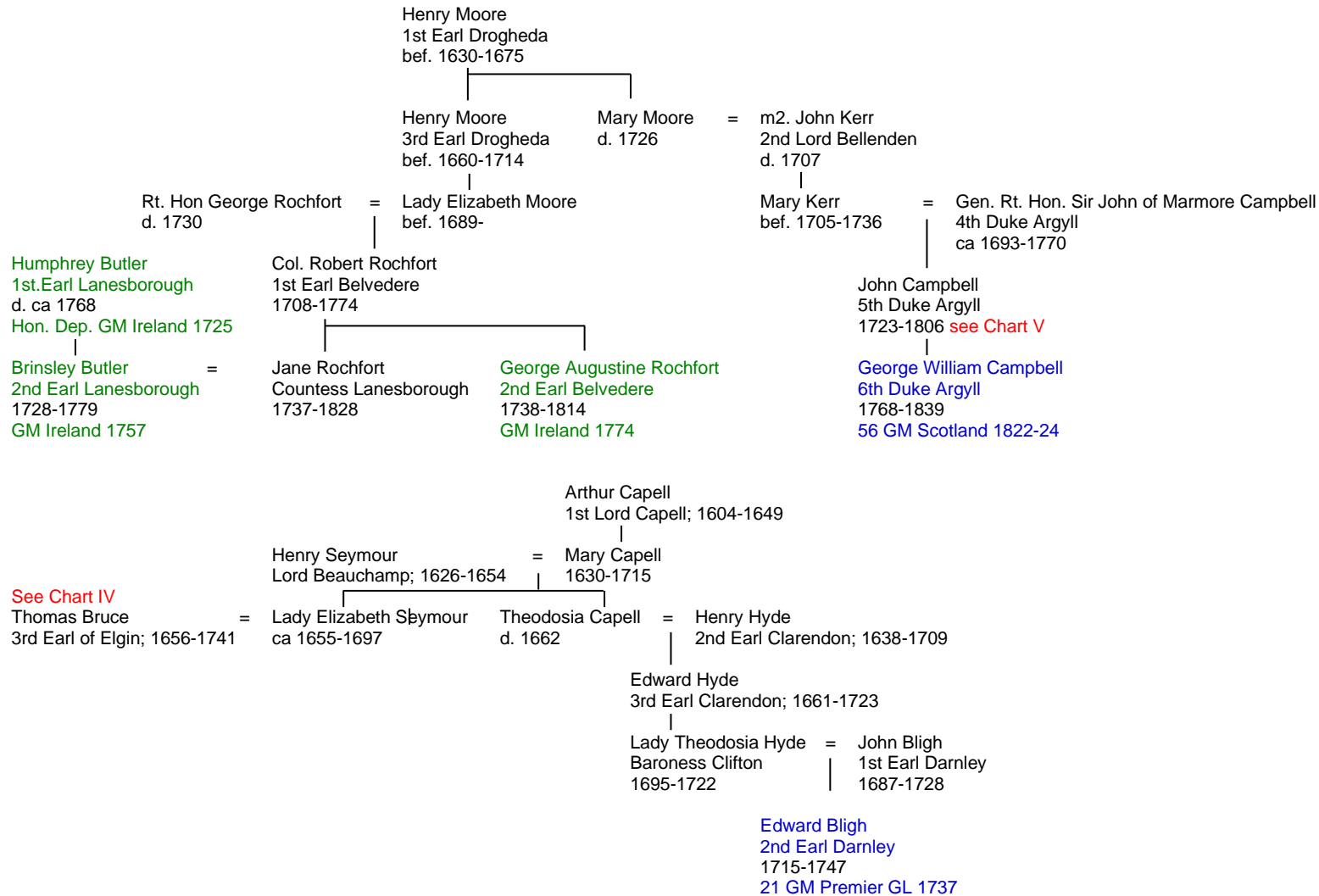

Some Genealogical Relationships of Grand Masters of England, Denmark & Norway

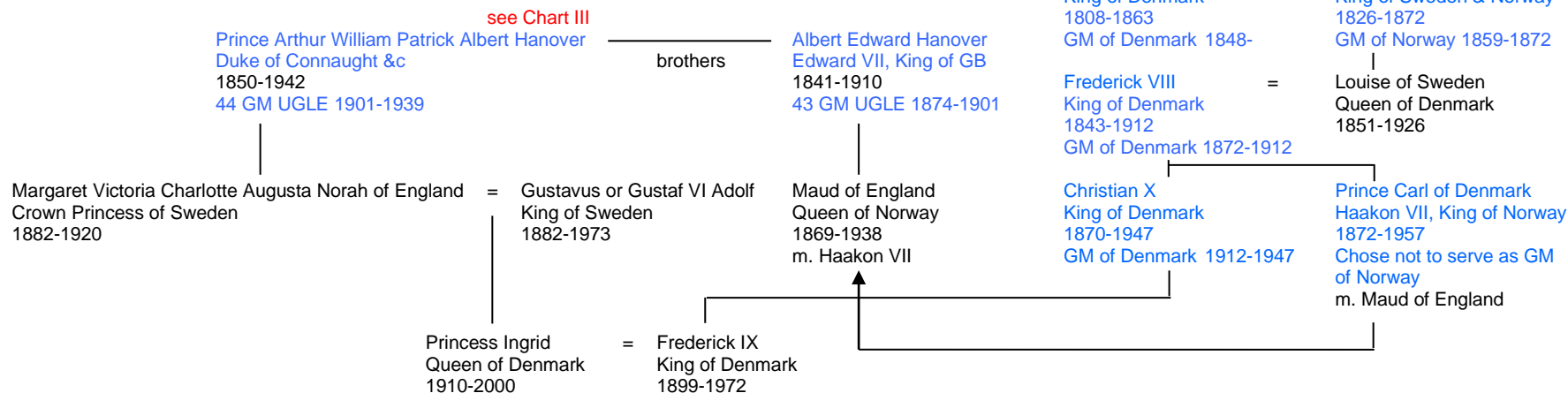
