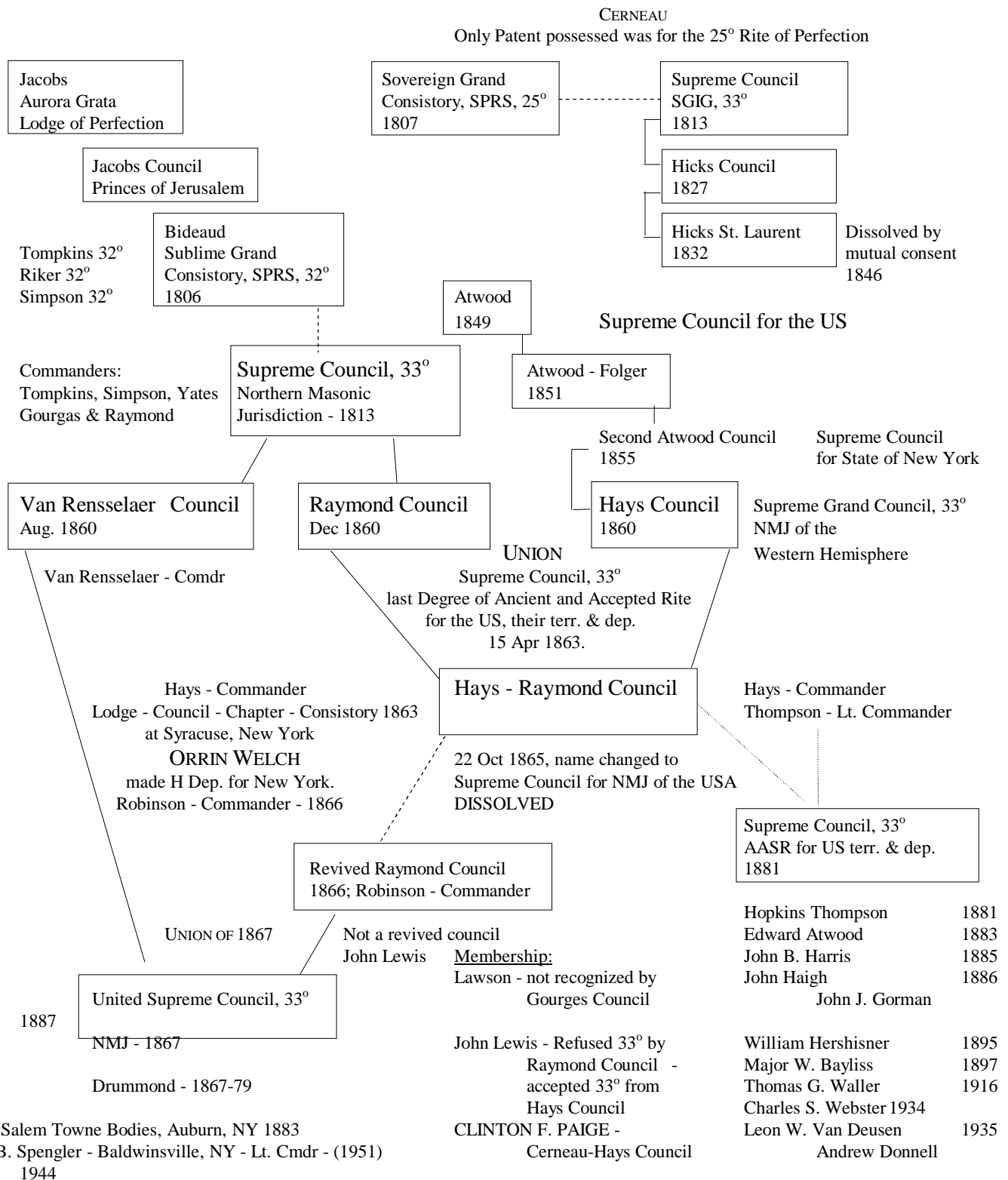


EVOLUTION OF THE SCOTTISH RITE IN THE STATE OF NEW YORK

Raymond & Robinson took their Council into Union with Hay's Council - Raymond became Comdr of the United Council - Name changed from S.C. 33° AASR for the US, their terr. & dep., to S.C. 33° for the NMJ of the USA in 1865. Robinson became Cmdr in 1866. Revived the Raymond Council by reason of Fiat, then he was Lt. Cmdr under Raymond. It is claimed that Albert Pike (S.C. 33° SMJ) and Robinson endeavored to solve division in AASR by this method. Union of 1867 took place. The residue of the Hay's Council revived the S.C. 33° of the US terr. & dep. in 1881. * Auburn had the four Bodies of this Council.
